Dear Parents,

We welcome this opportunity to help you with the Baptism of your child. It is our hope that this baptismal information packet will be helpful to you.

Enclosed you will find the information regarding the *Baptismal Preparation Program*. Our classes are scheduled by appointment at a convenient time for you and your godparents. If you are a first time parent or if you *or* your child's godparents have not attended a baptismal preparation class in the past three years, it is necessary to attend our class. If the godparents live or work a great distance away, they may attend a baptismal preparation class in their home parish so that they understand the obligations and responsibilities of their role. To schedule a Baptism class at St. Agnes, please call Marc Lecours at 860-904-3855. For St. Matthias, please call Deacon Jerry Shaw at 860-739-0049.

Also enclosed is the *baptismal questionnaire*. This questionnaire provides us with the information needed to complete the baptismal certificate and sacramental register for your child.

If your chosen godparent is an active member of our Parish, it is not necessary to complete/provide a *sponsor certificate*. However, if they are not members of our Parish, we ask that they complete the Godparent Eligibility Form, have it signed by their pastor and stamped with their church seal. This form is easily completed by dropping it off to their parish office. There is no charge for this but with priest's schedules and demands, it may take a few days or more to complete the process. Please build that into your schedule. If your godparent is completing the preparation class in their home parish, they will also need to provide you with a letter from their parish stating they have attended the class there.

In order to set the date for the Baptism of your child it is necessary to have completed and provide us with all paperwork on the day of your baptismal prep meeting OR TWO weeks prior to your planned baptismal date. Please understand that although we may set a target date, we will NOT confirm a baptism date until all paperwork is completed and has been received by the parish office. This includes the questionnaire as well as the sponsor certificates and pastor letters where necessary. Please allow enough time to complete all paperwork and training before your desired baptism date. You should allow at least 2 months lead time before scheduling your baptism and inviting guests.

As you know, Baptismal and all other sacramental records will be maintained for your child at our parish indefinitely. We request a donation of \$100 when your paperwork is completed which covers all recordkeeping.

If you are not already a registered member of our parish, please complete a Parish Registration Form. Blank forms can be found in the church, in the parish office and on our website: saintagnescatholicchurch.com.

If you and your spouse were not married in the Catholic Church, please call our Pastor, Fr. Gregory Mullaney at ext. 225 to schedule time to meet and discuss having your marriage convalidated (blessed) in the church.

BAPTISMAL PROGRAM AGENDA

You are about to have your child baptized. This is a very special celebration for you and your family, as well as a very important commitment for you to bring your child up in the practice of the Catholic Faith.

That is why the Church believes it is her most basic and necessary duty to inspire all; catechists, parents of children still to be baptized, and godparents, to the true and living Faith by which they adhere to Christ and enter into or confirm their commitment to the new covenant. To accomplish this, the Church prescribes the pastoral instruction of catechists, the preparation of the child's parents, the celebration of God's word, and the profession of baptismal faith.

- 1. The baptismal program and informational session differs slightly depending upon the class coordinator.
- 2. This program is for parents and godparents. Your child is welcome; however, extra time may be required with them in attendance.
- 3. Baptismal preparation is scheduled by appointment. To set up a convenient date and time that you and your child's godparents can attend, please call:

- 4. This baptismal program is a "priority".
- 5. Please choose your godparents carefully, realizing their utmost importance in helping you bring up your child in the Catholic Faith. Godparents often become Confirmation sponsors, too, and play a continuing role in the spiritual upbringing of your child.

REQUIREMENTS FOR A SPONSOR OR GODPARENT

- 1. The godparent should be mature enough to understand, accept and carry out the duties of a godparent. That person should be at least 16 years of age.
- 2. The godparent must have received the three Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation.
- 3. The godparent should be living an exemplary life consistent with faith and the responsibilities of a godparent through weekly attendance at Mass, following the teachings of Christ's Church, and <u>if married</u>, have been married in a Catholic Church in the presence of a Catholic priest and two witnesses.
- 4. The godparent must be a member of the Catholic Church. However, a baptized and believing Christian not belonging to the Catholic Church may act as a Christian witness as long as there is also a Catholic godparent who fulfills the above requirements.
- 5. If a Catholic godparent does not belong to this parish, he or she must obtain from the Pastor of their parish a Sponsor Certificate/Godparent Eligibility Form declaring that they are good practicing Catholics.
- 6. Each child may have only one godfather and one godmother.

Contractual Agreement

The sacrament of Baptism is normally celebrated for our parishioners following the last Mass on Sunday. Parents (and godparents) must attend a Baptism Preparation class. Please understand that we will **NOT** set a baptism date until all paperwork and requirements have been completed and received by the parish office. This includes the baptismal questionnaire as well as the sponsor certificates and pastor letters, where necessary. Please consider the preparation time necessary before planning a date. *Please allow at least 2 months lead time before scheduling your baptism and inviting guests.*

Godparents must be at least 16 years old, confirmed and actively practicing their Catholic faith, attending Mass weekly, and if married, they must be married according to the norms of the Catholic Church, i.e., they must have been married in a Catholic Church in the presence of a Catholic priest and two witnesses.

I understand my responsibilities in attending Baptismal prep class, choosing godparents, and completing/securing all necessary paperwork in order to have my child baptized. I understand that I will be unable to set a date until such time as all requirements have been met and that it is solely my responsibility to ensure the same.
